INTRADISTRICT OPEN ENROLLMENT

Before a student may be permitted to enroll in a school outside of his/her regular attendance area at parent request, the parents(s) or legal guardian(s) must have applied for an intradistrict open enrollment or an intradistrict regular attendance permit and have been granted authorization by the Assistant Superintendent of Student Services. Permits fall into two categories – open enrollment permits accepted through the lottery procedure and permits granted subsequent to and outside the lottery procedure.

The application requesting transfer will begin at the District office.

Students accepted on an open enrollment intradistrict permit through the lottery process will be allowed to complete the year. Parents must submit a Notification of Return form each school year for all permits. Any permit may be revoked for the following reasons as stated in Board Policy:

1. False information is used as a basis for securing an agreement.
2. Any of the conditions set forth for securing the agreement have changed to the extent that they would significantly alter the intent of the original agreement.

Non-lottery intradistrict regular permits may be revoked at any time if:

1. Continuance would lead to program or enrollment overload.
2. Student is excessively tardy or absent from school, or student is brought to school excessively early or left excessively late.
3. Student fails to uphold appropriate behavior standards.
4. Student fails to make appropriate academic efforts.
5. False or misleading information was provided.
6. Other conditions that occur that would render continuance inadvisable.
