SCHOOL ATTENDANCE BOUNDARIES

Attendance areas will ordinarily be determined for the following school year before the end of each school year and will remain as permanent as possible.

Boundaries for such areas will be determined primarily by consideration of the following factors:

1. Efficient and economical use of facilities.
2. Creation of a "neighborhood" type school.
3. Natural boundaries, if existent.
4. Compliance with class size requirements.
5. Compliance with state and federal laws.

Attendance areas shall be established by the Board upon the recommendation of the Superintendent.

All students living within a specific area shall attend the school designated for that area unless a transfer is granted by the East Whittier City School District.
