INTERDISTRICT ATTENDANCE

The Board of Trustees recognizes that the District may be able to accommodate students who live outside the District, however, overcrowding within District schools and limited District resources may cause District officials to deny permit requests. The Superintendent or designee may approve interdistrict attendance agreements for individual students when certain conditions are met. In accordance with Education Code Section 46604, the attendance of the student on permit shall be credited to the school district of attendance.

Conditions for Approval of Interdistrict Agreements

- Parent(s) or guardian(s) have obtained a written release from their district of residence when initially requesting a permit.
- Transfer agreements are with the East Whittier City School District and not with a specific school.
- Class enrollment in the District school of request will permit additional students.
- Parent(s) or guardian(s) assume full responsibility for providing transportation to and from school.

Interdistrict permits may be revoked if:

1. Continuance would lead to program or enrollment overload.
2. Student is excessively tardy or absent from school, or student is brought to school excessively early or left excessively late.
3. Student fails to uphold appropriate behavior standards.
4. Student fails to make appropriate academic efforts.
5. False or misleading information was provided.
6. Reason for the original issuance of the permit by the district of residence is no longer valid.
7. Other conditions that occur that would render continuance inadvisable.

INTERDISTRICT ATTENDANCE (continued)

Reasons to Approve Permit Requests in Order of Priority

1. Returning intradistrict permit students who have submitted their Notification of Return by May 1st.
2. Returning interdistrict permit students who have submitted their Notification of Return by June 1st.
3. Students in attendance who change residence during the year or for their last year at a school.
4. Parent request
 - a. The parent(s) or guardian(s) of a student is (are) employed in the East Whittier City School District for a minimum of 15 hours per week.
 - b. Siblings of students already on permit and in attendance at school of choice.
 - c. Parental choice.
