MIDDLE SCHOOL PROMOTION

1. One week prior to or following the end of quarters 1, 2 or 3, teachers will notify the principal of students receiving a grade of F.
2. As soon as a student is in danger of receiving a grade of F during quarter 4, teachers will notify the principal.
3. When a student is in danger of receiving a grade of F, his/her parents will be notified by the school.
4. Following the completion of each quarter, middle school students receiving a grade of F may be referred by teachers or administrators to the Student Study Team (SST) to determine if a grade adjustment study is necessary.
5. After receiving a grade of F, alternative adjustments and requirements shall be attempted as soon as possible to be completed according to a timeline and could include, but are not limited to, make-up learning packets, summer school, repeating a class, assignment to another class, tutoring, completing other coursework, a change of schools and any other adjustments and/or requirements deemed appropriate for a particular student.
6. Principals will establish a timeline describing the activities associated with the implementation of Board Policy 5123.1. This timeline will be communicated to students, teachers and parents affected by this policy at the beginning of quarter 4. The timeline will indicate final deadlines for students to complete appropriate alternative requirements.
7. If the timeline for appropriate alternative requirement(s) is met and the alternative requirement(s) is successfully completed, the student will be allowed to participate in the end of the year activities and will be promoted to the next grade level. Grade 8 students not completing the alternative requirement(s), according to the established timeline, will attend a summer school program and will not participate in end of the year activities, including promotional exercises.
