Student Medication

The principal, nurse or principal's designated adult representative shall supervise the self-ministering of medication which has been prescribed by a licensed physician for ingestion by a regular student at school during the regular school day. Written instructions and consent from the attending physician and the parent(s) or guardian(s) of the student shall be obtained prior to self-administration of such prescribed medication. Authorized adults will store such medication securely, remove proper dosage from containers (at proper times) and will be present when the student takes the medication.

The Superintendent or his designee shall be responsible for informing parent(s) or guardian(s) of all pupils of the requirement that the parent(s) or guardian(s) must inform the site administrator or school nurse of any medication being taken at home.
