HEALTH EXAMINATIONS

Examination may be provided by the principal or nurse to determine status of contagious disease.

District staff members shall cooperate with local, state and federal health officers in measures necessary for the prevention and control of communicable diseases in school age children, including the administration of immunizations to students whose parents have given prior consent in writing.

The district shall not infringe upon any religious beliefs or codes of law and will not undertake the administration of physical examination and/or immunization of those students who do not file a written consent signature of parent and/or guardian.
