Health Advisory Warning Episodes (Smog Alert)

Due to the known health hazards of air pollution, particularly for young people, it shall be the policy of the East Whittier City School District to protect students when there is an air pollution episode declared by the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD).

In accordance with South Coast Air Quality Management District Regulation VII - Emergencies, an emergency plan for the reduction of air contaminant emissions will be adopted.

This policy shall be administered by the assistant superintendent –personnel through members of his/her staff and through the respective building principals and their office staff members.

The principal shall establish and implement a procedure for notification of all teachers when so notified by the switchboard operator.
