SCHOOL-BASED PROGRAM COORDINATION ACT

Steps for Participation

- Step One: The local governing board adopts policies for the establishment of School Site Councils (SSC's).
- Step Two: The school site establishes a SSC.
- Step Three: The SSC identifies funding sources to be coordinated and develops a school plan.
- Step Four: The Board approves the plan.
- Step Five: The district notifies the State Department of Education of all School-Based Coordinated Program (SBCP) schools via Part 1 of the Consolidated Application (SDE 100) in June.
- Step Six: The SSC conducts annual evaluations of the school program.
