OUTSIDE CURRICULAR MATERIALS

Curricular materials donated or offered by outside individuals or organizations, to be used in the school or classroom, whether they be of commercial, cultural or philanthropic nature, must first be approved by the assistant superintendent, educational support services.

In setting forth this rule, the Board of Education does not wish to hinder the enriched effect certain commercial, cultural or philanthropic materials will bring to the educational program, but it does wish to safeguard the educational program of the East Whittier City School District against any charge or charges that the East Whittier City School District gives endorsement to commercial, cultural or philanthropic organizations unless, by Board action, permission for use is given. All such materials shall comply with the provisions relating to instructional materials listed in the Education Code.
