SUMMER SCHOOL

Summer school may be used to provide direct, systematic and intensive supplemental instruction to students in grades 2 through 8 who have been retained, identified as being at risk of retention, or identified as not making sufficient progress toward meeting grade level standards in mathematics, reading or written expression based on the results of the statewide Standardized Testing and Reporting Program and/or local measures.

The curriculum of the program shall reflect state academic content standards to the extent that the district curriculum is aligned with those state standards, and shall be designed to assist students to succeed on the exit examination.
