

Bylaws of the Board

LEGAL PROTECTION

Liability Insurance

The Board of Education shall provide liability insurance necessary to protect the Board members, officers and employees from any judgment as a result of suits brought against them alleging their liability. The insurance shall cover claims in such matters as civil rights actions, negligence or other acts resulting in accidental injury to any person or property damage in or out of the school buildings while the above-named insured are acting within the scope of their employment and/or under the direction of the Board of Education.
